

2024 Diversity in Contracting Annual Report

Report Highlights

- Port-wide (construction and non-construction): WMBE spend was 13.3% (\$124M) of the \$932M total Port spend, compared to its 15% goal for 2024
- Firms utilized: The Port worked with 388 WMBE firms in 2024, compared to its 400 firm's goal for 2024

Project Overview

Purpose: Upgrade aging electrical meter assets.

Background: Ports infrastructure is 30 years or older in many areas resulting in failing assets or assets which don't have spare parts to fix if broken.

Estimated Cost: \$10M - \$14M

WMBE Goal: 10%

Project Delivery Method: Design, Bid, Build



Teams will be evaluated on:

- Construction Administration & Contractor Pricing
- Project approach and schedule
- WMBE inclusion plan

Project Scope

- Replacement of outdated electrical meters with new standard electrical meters (approximately 800 meters)
- All meters will be networked into existing Port infrastructure.
- Meters are being replaced to meet current code requirements (Washington State Energy Code, Clean Building Performance Standard, and IEEE 1547).




Meter Comparison

Existing Meters







New Meters





- Network integration not possible
- Spare parts not readily available
- Warranty expired

- All meters on centralized database
- Network integration possible meeting updated code requirements
- Data easier to access resulting in cost reductions for projects
- Spare parts easily available

Background: SBM Office (A-1) was originally constructed in 2005. Majority of furniture, fixtures, and flooring are from the original 2005 buildout.



Project Scope


- Demo customer service counter, workstations and furniture (does not include facilities office, three (3) personal offices, kitchenette, and conference room)

- New flooring throughout area of work
- Install new LED lighting fixtures
- Reconfigure electrical and data to provide power to new workstations
- Repaint all walls in area of work
