RESOLUTION NO 2149

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle amending the By-Laws of the Port of Seattle and repealing any prior resolutions in conflict therewith

BEIT RESOLVED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle, as follows

SECTION 1 The provisions of Article II of the Port's By-Laws shall be and the same are hereby amended by changing paragraph (2) to read as tollows

- (2) The Commission shall elect new officers at its first public meeting following the beginning of each year, whose term shall run for one year beginning when elected, and until the election of a successor. Vacancies in an office arising from any cause may be filled at any regular or special meeting of the Commission.

 SECTION 2 Article III shall be amended by adding an additional paragraph (4) at end of Article III to read as follows.
 - (4) The Assistant Secretary shall, during the absence or disability of the Secretary, exercise all the functions of the Secretary

 SECTION 3 This resolution shall become effective upon its adoption

SECTION 4 All prior resolutions of the Port Commission in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed
