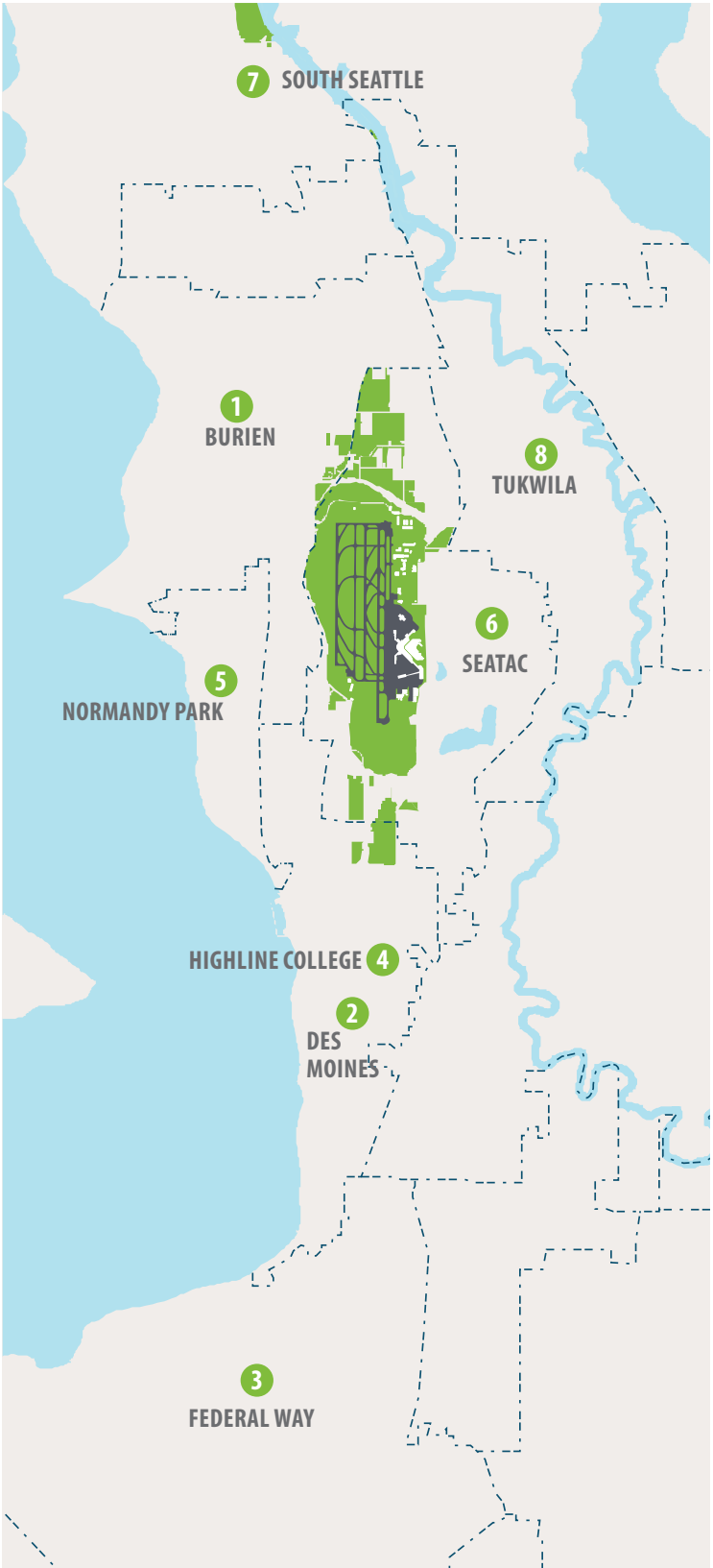

AIRPORT COMMUNITY ECOLOGY FUND FORTERRA GREEN CITIES PLANS

Paid Forterra to develop Green Cities land stewardship plans for communities near SEA Airport

AIRPORT COMMUNITY ECOLOGY GRANT PROGRAM

Matching grants distributed to non-profit organizations near the airport to support community environmental projects between 2017 and 2019. South King County Community Impact Fund Environmental Grant Program continues this work

AIRPORT JOBS

Links job seekers to job opportunities at SEA Airport and provides job search and career support

AIRPORT UNIVERSITY

Provides career support, career-connected learning, scholarships, and free college classes to airport workers

DES MOINES CREEK BASIN PLAN

A walking and biking trail and water quality enhancements along Des Moines Creek

\$\$ DIRECT TAXES

Taxes from airport economic activity benefit communities through retail sales tax, leasehold excise taxes, and commercial parking taxes

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM

Funding economic development initiatives across King County through matching grants

HILLGROVE CEMETERY PROPERTY IMPROVEMENTS

Improving infrastructure of a historic cemetery near SEA Airport

MILLER CREEK DAYLIGHTING PROJECT

Restoring a stream and creating additional salmon spawning habitat in Burien and SeaTac

OPPORTUNITY YOUTH INITIATIVE

Supporting 200 summer jobs for underserved youth and provides funding to local non-profit organizations

PUBLIC SAFETY

Sharing unique aircraft rescue and aviation firefighting training and police department public safety response training and equipment to provide mutual aid to neighboring jurisdictions

PUGET SOUND GATEWAY SR509 EXTENSION

Supported an initiative to build highway infrastructure to better link I-5 to the Port of Tacoma, SEA Airport, and the Port of Seattle

SEA SPOTLIGHT ADVERTISING

Reserving free advertising space at SEA Airport for cities, counties, port authorities, and state non-profit organizations to advertise their region or destination to travelers

SOUTH KING COUNTY COMMUNITY IMPACT FUND ECONOMIC RECOVERY PROGRAM

Supporting community-led projects to help community members acquire the skills, experience, and education needed to secure family-wage jobs at the Port and in port-related industries

SOUTH KING COUNTY COMMUNITY IMPACT FUND ENVIRONMENTAL GRANTS PROGRAM

Providing resources and support to communities near the airport to address airport noise and improve environmental health and sustainability

SOUTH KING COUNTY COMMUNITY IMPACT FUND — SBDC AND STARTZONE

Collaborating with the Washington Small Business Development Center (SBDC) at Highline College to support entrepreneurs from marginalized communities in South King County.
