  - Trucking Industry
- CAWG have invited non-voting members who have declined
- Work group had concerns about participation by members with expired terms
- Process for hiring a consultant

## Consultant Selection Process Underway

- Review existing research
- Also providing briefings on:
  - Air Service Analysis
  - Washington State Legal Issues
  - Construction timelines and costs
  - Advanced Air Mobility
  - Small Community Air Service
  - Multi-modal Transportation Planning
- Proposals due September 5
