



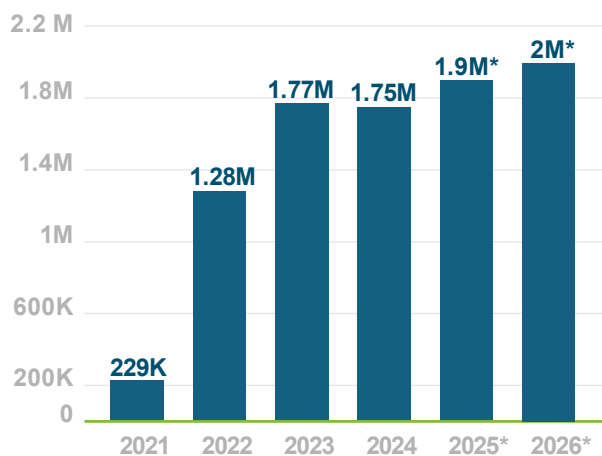
CRUISE SEATTLE 2026

The 2026 Alaska cruise season will bring 15 cruise lines and 26 different ships to Seattle's cruise terminals. Local cruise industry workers, suppliers, and tourism businesses can anticipate 330 port calls and 2+ million cruise visitors from May through October.

PORT OF SEATTLE CRUISE TERMINALS

Two downtown cruise terminals and convenient air travel connections make Seattle the preferred choice for Alaska, Pacific Northwest, and West Coast cruises.



SMITH COVE CRUISE TERMINAL AT PIER 91

With two cruise berths located at the north end of Seattle's waterfront on historic Smith Cove, Pier 91 is just 10 minutes from the city's retail core. Cruise guests enjoy easy access to bus parking, taxis, airport shuttles, a private vehicle drop-off area, and a dedicated app-based rideshare lot.



BELL STREET PIER CRUISE TERMINAL AT PIER 66

With one cruise berth located at the heart of Seattle's downtown waterfront, Pier 66 is within walking distance from the famous Pike Place Market, Space Needle, new Waterfront Overlook Park, and numerous shops and restaurants. Ground transportation at the terminal entrance provides easy access to bus parking, taxis, airport shuttle service, private vehicle drop off, and a rideshare zone.

SEATTLE IS SHORE POWER ENABLED

All of the Port of Seattle's cruise facilities are now fully equipped with shore power at every berth, making Seattle one of the few ports in the world with this comprehensive capability. This allows cruise ships to plug into Seattle's electrical grid while docked — reducing carbon emissions for the people who visit, live, and work here.



PORT VALET

Port Valet helps cruise visitors enjoy Seattle without their heavy bags. Exclusive to the Port of Seattle, Port Valet will transfer luggage from the cruise ship directly to the airport. Participating cruise guests can go straight to their gate without checking luggage at SEA Airport.
