MEETING SUMMARY

JUNE 8, 2026; 5:00 PM – 7:00 PM

Meeting Objectives: Update on the Part 150 Noise Study's draft Noise Compatibility Plan measures and a further discussion regarding the Late Night Noise Limitation Program's established hours.

Part 150 Noise Study Technical Review Committee

- II. Introduction, Tom Fagerstrom, Noise Programs Manager
 - The Part 150 Study is at its halfway point.
 - The Noise Exposure Map (NEM) report is nearly ready for posting on the website, pending preliminary comments from the FAA.
 - The team has moved into the second phase of the Part 150 process, focusing on noise compatibility program measures, with initial analyses being conducted on potential measures such as noise abatement, land use mitigation, and programmatic initiatives.

- IV. Aviation Near-Term Noise Action Agenda, Tom Fagerstrom, POS & Paris Edwards, Noise Programs Coordinator, POS
 - Updates on late night noise exceedances
 - Q1 2026 numbers were up slightly from previous quarters due to a new Asiana Airlines passenger flight leaving around midnight.
 - The team discussed plans to reach out to ATI/Amazon regarding their operations and scheduling, while noting challenges with contacting Asiana due to their ongoing acquisition by Korean Airlines.
 - Go-around events in April and May remained at normal levels with no significant issues, and a noted decrease in noise complaints in 2026 (so far) compared to previous years, though this requires further monitoring.
- V. Late Night Noise Limitation Program Review (Part 2), Paris Edwards, POS & Vince Mestre, Consultant

- The group reviewed data on late-night and early-morning operations at SEA, analyzing 665 flights between 5:00 AM and 6:00 AM in August 2025.
- Findings showed more arrivals (385) versus departures (280), with the Embraer 175 being the most used aircraft type during the hour.
- The tight scheduling is driven by airline hub operations and the need to position aircraft for busy morning departure periods, making it difficult to expand the Late Night Noise Limitation Program during the additional 5 AM to 6 AM hour.

VI. Fly Quiet Awards, Paris Edwards, POS

- The Fly Quiet award winners Air Canada, Icelandair and Frontier Airlines received top honors.

VII. Sound Insulation Update, Ryan McMullan, Noise Programs Senior Manager, POS

- The updates on the sound insulation program progress included completion of 57 apartment units and ongoing work on places of worship. For the Pilot Program, 9 homes have acoustically tested eligible.

- Update on the Roundtable of Airport Roundtables meeting.
 - Participants discussed potential focus areas including health impacts, data collection, legislative work, and technology.
